To Read or Listen on your Phone, Tablet or Reader

To access eBooks/eAudiobooks on your phone, tablet or reader,

 Download the BorrowBox app from your device-specific App Store (<u>Google Play</u>) (<u>Apple App Store</u>) (<u>Kindle Fire</u>).

Once you have installed the app,

- Search for **Longford** in the dropdown "Library" menu provided
- Enter your Library card number where it asks you for your ID/Barcode
- Enter your four digit PIN where it asks for you PIN/Password.

That's it, you're signed in and ready to browse and read!

Online Newspapers

National publications include the *Irish Examiner*, and *Irish Daily Mirror*, along with *Hot Press* and *Image* magazine. You also have access to back issues and can have new issues of your favourite publications delivered automatically to your device.

Reading on your computer or laptop

To access newspapers on your PC or laptop, go to <u>www.pressreader.com</u>.

How to use PressReader for online newspapers

You will need to log in with your Library number, here's how:

- Click on the "Sign in" icon
- Click on the "Library or Group" option
- A list of Libraries will then open from which you can choose **Longford County Library.** Simply start typing **Longford** and it should appear next to the Libraries Ireland logo.
- You will then be asked to enter your Library card number.

That's it – you're now logged in and ready to read!

Your login grants you 30 days access initially. When these 30 days have expired a new period can be started simply by logging out and back in using the same method.

How to use RB Digital for online magazines

- Visit the website at https://lgma.rbdigitalglobal.com/ where you will need to register for your free account
- Click **REGISTER** on the top right-hand side of the website
- Select Longford County Libraries from the dropdown menu
- Enter your name, library card number and email address
- Create a username and password.

That's it, you're all set up.
